All NCPA Facilities Hill Brothers Chemical Company MTEMS Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of a five-year Multi-Task Agreement for Purchase of Equipment, Materials and Supplies with Hill Brothers Chemical Company for chemical purchases, with a not to exceed amount of \$2,500,000, for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA.
