- 2. Approve minutes from the February 3<sup>rd</sup>, February 16<sup>th</sup> and February 17<sup>th</sup> Facilities Committee meetings.
- 3. Services Offer to Marin Clean Energy Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval to submit an offer to provide Scheduling Coordination, Load Forecasting and Portfolio Management Services to Marin Clean Energy.
- **4.** Power Management and Administrative Services Cost Allocation Study Staff will provide an update on the proposed changes to cost allocation model inputs.
- 5. All Generation Services Facilities, Members and SCPPA Maxim Crane Works, LP Agreement Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of a five year Multi-Task General Services Agreement with Maxim Crane Works, LP for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for crane services for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, its Members, SCPPA, and SCPPA Members. All purchase orders issued pursuant to the agreement will be charged against approved Annual Operating budgets. (Sponsor CTs)

- 6. All Generation Services Facilities, Members and SCPPA Utility System Efficiencies, Inc. Agreement Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of a five year Multi-Task Professional Services Agreement with Utility System Efficiencies, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$300,000 for consulting services related to WECC and NERC reliability criteria for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, its Members, SCPPA, and SCPPA Members. All purchase orders issued pursuant to the agreement will be charged against approved Annual Operating budgets. (Sponsor CTs)
- 7. Developing Trends in Renewable Energy Staff to present future scenarios for renewable energy in light of solar production and potential effects on renewable energy certificates. (Sponsor Generation Services)
- **8. Hydroelectric Facility Adit 4 Stockpile Erosion** Staff will provide an informational update on the site status. (Sponsor Hydro)
- CT1 Lodi Facility Outage Staff will provide a progress report on the status of the Turner Road outage. (Sponsor CTs)
- **10. CT1 Project Alameda and Lodi Facilities** Staff will discuss budget assumptions and future direction for CT1 project. (Sponsor CTs)
- **11. Schedule next meeting date** The next Facilities Committee meeting is currently scheduled for March 30<sup>th</sup>. NOTE: A Special Facilities Committee meeting will be held March 16th to continue review of the FY17 proposed budgets.
