1. Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call

PUBLIC FORUM

Any member of the public who wishes to address the Committee on matters not on the Agenda, but within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee, or any member of the public who desires to address the Committee on any item considered by the Committee at this meeting before or during the Committee's consideration of that item, shall so advise the Chair and shall thereupon be given an opportunity to do so.

2. Approve minutes from the March 30th Facilities Committee meeting.

3. **Geothermal Facility** – Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of the 2016 Steam Field Operations Forecast Report dated April 2016 as the Geothermal Operating Protocol effective July 1, 2016 and to remain in effect until replaced by the Commission (Sponsor Geo).

4. **All Generation Services Facilities, Members, SCPPA & SCPPA Members – Black & Veatch Corporation** – Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of a five year Multi-Task Professional Services Agreement with Black & Veatch Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for project support and plant operation consulting services for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, its Members, SCPPA, and SCPPA Members. All purchase orders issued pursuant to the agreement will be charged against approved Annual Operating budgets (Sponsor CTs).

5. **All Generation Services Facilities, Members, SCPPA & SCPPA Members – WEST Consultants, Inc.** – Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of a five year Multi-Task Professional Services Agreement with WEST Consultants, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 for various professional and engineering services, such as hydrological flow modeling, for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, its Members, SCPPA, and SCPPA

Members. All purchase orders issued pursuant to the agreement will be charged against approved Annual Operating budgets (Sponsor Hydro).

6. **McKay's Reservoir Parameters and Economics Presentation** – Staff will provide information regarding changes in McKay's Reservoir operating parameters and Collierville market revenues from FY2011 to current.
7. **Calaveras Project Shares Unwinding for Pool and Roseville** – Staff will provide information regarding the true-up of water shares from NCPA Pool and Roseville Combined Calaveras Project Operations.
8. **Enhanced Bidding Capability for Participants in the CAISO Real-Time Energy Market** – Staff will provide information regarding plans to expand capability for multiple operating entities to participate in the CAISO real-time energy market.
9. **Update to Scheduling Coordination Program Agreement (SCPA) Appendix B** – Staff is seeking a recommendation for Commission approval of the most recent changes made to the SCPA Appendix B.
10. **Merced Irrigation District Services Offer** – NCPA staff are seeking authorization to submit an offer to provide Services to Merced Irrigation District ("MID") in response to MID's February 26, 2016 request for proposals for Hydro Project Scheduling Coordination Services.
11. **Planning and Operations Update** – Staff will provide an update on issues related to planning and operations.
12. **Power Management and Administrative Services Cost Allocation Study** – Staff will provide an update regarding the status of NCPA's effort to review the Power Management and Administrative Services Cost Allocation Study.
