Subject: September 27, 2017 Legislative & Regulatory Affairs Committee Meeting Minutes

Item #1-Opening Remarks & Introductions

Chair Teresa O'Neill, Councilmember, City of Santa Clara, called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm, followed by introductions of all in attendance.

Item #2 – Approval of Minutes

Motion: A motion was made, and seconded, to approve the minutes from the August 23, 2017 regular meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

REPORTS AND ACTION ITEMS (3:10pm-5:00pm)

Item #3 – Presentations & Discussion

NCPA invited a panel of senior state energy and environmental policy leaders to discuss key issues of importance to public power including the state's cap and trade program, regionalization, and SB 100.

Terry Crowley, Utilities Director, City of Healdsburg provided introductions for each of the panelists: Kip Lipper, Chief Policy Advisor for Energy and Environment to California State Senate President pro Tem Kevin de Leon; Nidia Bautista, Consultant for the California State Senate Energy, Utilities and Communication Committee; Marie Liu, Advisor to the Speaker of the California State Assembly on environmental issues including natural resources, toxics, and climate; Edie Chang, Deputy Executive Officer, California Air Resources Board; Tom Doughty, Vice President of Customer and State Affairs at the California Independent System Operator; and Rob Oglesby, Executive Director of the California Energy Commission.

Kip Lipper spoke about the status and legislative issues related to SB 100, grid regionalization, and the Public Utilities Commission. Marie Liu spoke about the Assembly's cap and trade bills in 2017, as well as the Assembly Speaker's philosophy of empowering committee chairs. Tom Doughty spoke about the challenges with renewable energy over-generation, and the role of the

energy imbalance market and grid regionalization to address the problem. Edie Chang spoke about the state's cap and trade program, upcoming workshops on the scoping plan, SB 350's integrated resource plan emission targets, and the air quality provisions in the recently passed cap and trade legislation. Nidia Bautista spoke about grid regionalization, retail choice (e.g., community choice aggregators), and the Senate Energy, Utilities and Communications chair's philosophy on clean energy policies. Rob Oglesby reflected on the wide range of changes that have been undertaken in the energy sector during the seven years he has served as CEC Executive Director.

The meeting was adjourned by Chair O'Neill at 5:00 pm.
