General Scope of Work

- This is a Three year existing agreement from April 27, 2015 to April 27, 2018
- Enabling Agreement
- Amended cost goes from \$150,000 to \$500,000
 Scope of Work

Accepts waste (both hazardous and non hazardous) from the Geothermal Facility



Background

- The GEO produces a small amount of hazardous waste including an occasional bin (less than 5% of all Sulphur production) of hazardous Sulphur
- During the last 15 years or more 95% of that Sulphur has been tested as non hazardous has been used in the farming industry (primarily for a soil amendment for Almonds)
- The prior user of the Sulphur has recently decided to retire and no longer will accept the Sulphur
- We are actively pursuing an agreement with another company
- Until we have an agreement, the only disposal site that is able to accept the Sulphur is Chemical Waste Management



Proposal

 Staff is seeking a recommendation from the Facilities Committee for Commission approval for an Amendment to the existing Three Year Agreement with Chemical Waste Management increasing the 'not to exceed' amount from \$150,000 to \$500,000
