



**Kobelco Compressors America, Inc.
First Amendment to Multi-Task
General Services Agreement**

Background

- NCPA entered into a Five Year Multi-Task General Services Agreement with Kobelco Compressors America, Inc., effective February 28, 2022, to provide off-site fuel gas compressor overhaul related services as requested by NCPA, NCPA Member, SCPPA and SCPPA Member facilities.
- NCPA's Lodi Energy Center had a mechanical seal fail on the Fuel Gas Compressor "B" and the compressor needs to be sent to Kobelco for maintenance.
- The agreement does not have enough funds to cover these anticipated costs.
- Need to increase the NTE from \$200K to \$1MM for the remainder of the agreement expiring February 28, 2027.

General Scope of Work

- Cost = Increase Not to Exceed from \$200K to \$1MM

- Scope of Work
 - Off-site fuel gas compressor overhaul related services

- Similar Agreements in Place:
 - None at this time, Kobelco is the OEM for LEC's fuel gas compressors

Environmental Analysis

- As an enabling agreement, this activity would not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect change in the physical environment and is therefore not a “project” for purposes of Section 21065 the California Environmental Quality Act. No environmental review is necessary.

Selection Process

- This enabling agreement does not commit NCPA to any expenditure of funds. At the time services are needed, NCPA will bid the specific scope of work consistent with NCPA procurement policies and procedures. NCPA seeks bids from qualified providers as required. Bids are awarded to the vendor providing the best overall value to NCPA. NCPA will issue purchase orders based on cost and availability of the services needed at the time the service is required.

Proposal

- Staff is seeking a recommendation from the Facilities Committee for Commission approval of the First Amendment to the five-year Multi-Task General Services Agreement with Kobelco Compressors America, Inc. for off-site fuel gas compressor overhaul related services, increasing the not to exceed amount from \$200,000 to \$1,000,000 and amending Section 11 – Warranty to add clarifying language regarding equipment warranty as requested by the vendor, with no change to the contract term, for continued use by any facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, NCPA members, SCPPA and SCPPA Members.
