### **Transportation Electrification**

- Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS)
  equity-spending requirements start in
  2020
  - For credits resulting from residential charging
- One-time reporting requirement for fleets due May 1, 2021
- Advanced Clean Fleets regulatory proposal





### **Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF)**

- New regulatory proposal for public, private, and drayage fleets
- The regulation applies to:
  - Vehicles with a gross vehicle weight over 8,500 lbs. (Medium-Duty and Heavy-Duty) – Class 2b and up
  - Does not cover: transit vehicles subject to the ICT regulation, emergency vehicles defined by vehicle code section 165, school buses
- Implementation timeframe is from 2023 to 2045









### **Requirements for Public Fleets**

- Proposed requirement for public fleet:
  - Requirement is on fleet purchases and replacements.
  - No requirement to replace early.
  - 50% of 2024-2026 model years must be ZEV
  - 100% of 2027 and newer model years must be ZEVs
  - PHEVs allowed until 2035



- Public fleet exemptions:
  - Three-year exemption for low population counties such as Butte, Mendocino, Plumas, Sierra, Shasta
  - Exemptions for "situations beyond fleet control," no availability, manufacturer delays



#### **RFP for Income Verification Services**

- RFP was issued on April 22, 2021, in response to Member requests
  - Members are interested in assistance with income verification, because of an increasing need for equityfocused programs, as well as rate-assistance and COVIDsupport programs.



- Proposals will be evaluated in partnership with volunteers from the Customer Programs Working Groups
- Resulting contracts for income verification services expected to be available by September 2021





#### **Contract Extensions for Demand-Side Services**

- NCPA issued an RFP in 2018 for:
  - Evaluation, Measurement, and Verification (EM&V)
    Services
  - Demand-side Technical Advisory Services
- NCPA entered into contracts with ADM Associates,
  Cadmus Group, and Energy & Resource Solutions
  - Energy & Resource Solutions has been acquired by DNV Energy Services USA Inc., and the contract needs to be amended to change vendor name
- Members have expressed interest in extending the existing agreement terms from 3-5 years

## Federal Legislative COVID-19 Relief

#### **American Rescue Plan Act**


- Allows local governments to access payroll tax credits to offset costs of paid emergency sick leave
- Provides \$350 billion in CRF 60% for states, 40% for localities
- \$4.5 billion in LIHEAP
- \$19 billion for Emergency Renter Assistance Program
- \$10 billion for Homeowners Assistance
  Fund
- No moratorium on power shut-offs

### Western (WAPA) - Central Valley Project Hydropower

#### **Below Average Water Year Creating Problems**

- Reduced CVP hydropower base resource generation
- Bypass Operations at Shasta Dam
  - Following a test, bypasses began on April 18, 2021 and may continue through May 31, 2021
  - NCPA requested reimbursement for foregone CVP generation
  - Potential implications to other reservoirs and longer term decisions
- Drought may constrain WAPA's EIM participation which kicked off March 25, 2021

#### **Other CVP Updates**

- Awaiting Reclamation's decisions on CVPIA Business Practice Guidelines
- Members approved and submitted CVP 2025 Base Resource Contracts
- Next steps: Monitor costs and prepare for 2023 rate design and development











## **State Legislative Issues 2021 Policy Bill Process**





### **State Budget**

- Higher than expected tax revenues + federal assistance = significant one-time surplus
- Governor's "May Revise"
- Senate "Build Back Boldly" Proposal
- POU Request for COVID-19 Relief to Address Customer Arrearages
  - \$1 billion for publicly owned electric utilities and water agencies



The State Budget deadline is June 15




