- 4. PRESENTATION "PUBLIC UTILITY RATES STRUCTURES: LIMITATIONS AND OPTIONS." In 2022, California Assembly Bill 205 was signed into law, providing a framework for the CPUC to establish income-graduated fixed charges. Matthew Slentz of Colantuono, Highsmith & Whatley, will discuss what this means for public power, focusing on public utility rate restrictions covering income-graduated fixed charges, California Supreme Court cases, and Initiative 1935. NCPA General Counsel Jane Luckhardt will moderate the discussion. (Information Item)
