

MATHESON TRI-GAS, INC. First Amendment to Multi-Task General Services Agreement

Background

- Various gases are required at the NCPA locations from time to time. Matheson Tri-Gas, Inc. is a provider of these services.
- NCPA entered into a Five Year Multi-Task General Services Agreement with Matheson Tri-Gas, Inc. effective November 5, 2014.
- Amendment will increase the not to exceed amount from \$200,000 to \$750,000, add additional delivery facility locations and add products to the Purchase List.
- Enabling Agreement NCPA will seek bids from as many qualified providers as possible and enter into additional enabling agreements as needed. The bid is awarded to the lowest cost provider.

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General Scope of Work

- Five Year Agreement
- Scope of Work Includes:
 - Supply various gases required for plant operations.
 - Products to include, but not be limited to:
 - Nitrogen
 - Oxygen
 - Agron
 - SF6



Environmental Analysis

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Proposal

Approval of Resolution 17-XX authorizing the General Manager or his designee to enter into a First Amendment to Multi-Task General Services Agreement with Matheson Tri-Gas, Inc., with any nonsubstantial changes recommended and approved by the NCPA General Counsel, which shall not exceed \$750,000 over five years for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA.

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
