Background

- Crane services are needed at various NCPA locations as well as member facilities for the operation of the plants.
- Enabling Agreement
- NCPA currently has enabling agreement with Titan Crane and Summit Crane for similar services.
- NCPA will seek bids from as many qualified providers as possible and enter into additional enabling agreements as needed. The bid is awarded to the lowest cost provider.

General Scope of Work

- Five Year Agreement
- Scope of Work Includes:
 - Engineering and Project Management for crane rental projects
 - Crane and lift training
 - Engineered crane lifts
 - Crane rentals and crane rental services
 - Rigging services / Transportation services
 - Heavy lifts / Heavy transportation services
 - On-site evaluations
 - Operated and Maintained Crane Rental
 - Base Crane Rental

Environmental Analysis

- This activity would not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect change in the physical environment and is therefore not a “project” for purposes of Section 21065 the California Environmental Quality Act. No environmental review is necessary.

Proposal

- Staff is seeking a recommendation from the Facilities Committee for Commission approval of the Multi-Task General Services Agreement between NCPA and Maxim Crane Works, LP in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for crane services for use at all facilities owned and/or operated by NCPA, its Members, SCPPA, and SCPPA Members.
