Background

- The original enabling agreement with Pengo Wireline of California, Inc. is a three year Multi-Task General Services Agreement for not to exceed \$180,000 due to expire on July 10, 2018
- Pengo has consistently been the low cost wireline provider
- Due to winning the bids, the contract is nearly out of money
- The proposed First Amendment seeks to increase the not to exceed amount from \$180,000 to \$500,000

General Scope of Work

- The only change to the contract is the not to exceed amount increasing from \$180,000 to \$500,000
- Pengo Wireline would provide 'hoisting' services for
 - Casing Calipers
 - BLM Mandated Pressure Temperature Surveys
 - High Temperature Camera runs
 - Gauge ring runs and several other Wireline Services
