# Lathrop Irrigation District was formed to serve the River Islands Community

#### **Current Statistics:**

- 400 homes are currently occupied
- 150 homes set up with utilities and ready to sell
- 50 miscellaneous meters
- Last year's Peak load was 1.4 MW; ~38.0% load factor resulting in ~4,900 MWh
- This year's peak is expected to be 2.5 MW growing to 5 MW within three years



### Lathrop Irrigation District Current Statistics:

- Calpine is Lathrop's current schedule coordinator (SC)
- SC contract expired January 31, 2017
- SC contract currently at \$4,000 with a 12% escalator or \$48,000/year
- Next year's cost will be approximately \$53,760
- Lathrop currently has 4 NP15 contracts with Calpine totaling 0.4 MW; remaining position bought at day-ahead prices
- Calpine took over contract when it acquired Noble Energy
